DIRECTIONS: Take I-5 to Exit #104 (US 101); Black Lake/West Olympia Exit; turn Left, Left on Delphi Rd; 2.1 miles turn Right on Waddell Cr Rd; 3.7 miles turn Left on Waddell Cr Rd; 0.6 miles turn Right to Middle Waddell Day Use Area

General Information

- 30+ Mile course of medium difficulty terrain with reasonable speed averages.
- Full range of time keeping challenges.
- NMA Enduro Rules Apply.
- Tech Inspection: Spark arrestor required & either ORV Tabs or Street Registration.
- Mandatory sound test
 - 98 dba for water cooled bikes
 - 102 dba for air cooled bikes

Fees & Limits

- \$20 Entry fee. (no pre-entry)
- FREE Roll Charts for Enduro course.
- 150 Rider limit, 2 riders per minute.
- Motorcycles only.
- Awards presented at approximately 5:00pm.
- Top 30% receive awards.
- Competition License holders are not eligible for awards.

NMA Enduro Definition

An Enduro is a meet where speed is not the determining factor and where a time schedule has to be maintained. It is conducted over little-used roads, trails, footpaths, and all other types of terrain which can be negotiated by the motorcycle or the muscular energy of the rider.

The Schedule

- Sign-up 8:30am – 11:00am
- Enduro School 9:30am – 11:00am
- Tech Inspection 11:00am – 11:30am
- First Rider out 12:01pm
- Classes: 15 & under, Small Bore (200cc & under), Open (over 200cc), Ladies, Over the Hill (40 & over), Seat of the Pants (no Odometer), Sandbagger (experience/pro riders)
